In accordance with AKC Obedience Regulations, entries in these tests will be accepted up to the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limits may have been reached. These tests are open to all registerable dogs at least six months of age.

Should the number of entries exceed the number of tracks available, a drawing to determine which entries will participate in the tests will be held Thursday, April 19, 2018 at 7:00 P.M. at the home of the Event Secretary.

CERTIFICATION: A written statement must accompany each entry for a licensed or member tracking test for any dog that has not previously passed an AKC TD Test. This statement must be dated within one year of the date the test is to be held, signed by a person approved to judge tracking tests, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily perform a certification test.

Fax, telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable. Entries will not be accepted without fees.

Error on Entry: Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in event of errors or cancellation of entry after the published closing date. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted after the entries have closed.

The assignment of dogs to the tracks, by drawing of lots, is the responsibility of the judges on test day.

The test secretary shall then notify all entries of the results of the draw by phone and email. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternates are present and to determine, by their position on the alternate list, which of the alternates shall participate.

Entries will be acknowledged and a judging schedule emailed as soon as practical after entries close. Should an acknowledgement not be received within a reasonable amount of time, please contact the Event Secretary

From the West: Take I-90 to Marengo/Hampshire Exit-Rt 20. Turn right onto Rt 20. Turn right onto Allen to the Forest Preserve.

From the East: Take I-90 to Huntley Exit-Rt 47. Turn left onto Rt 47. Turn right onto Rt 20. Turn slight left onto Allen to the Forest Preserve.

From the North: Take Rt 47. Turn right onto Rt 20. Turn slight left onto Allen to the Forest Preserve.

From the South: Take Rt 47. Turn left onto Rt 20. Turn slight left onto Allen to the Forest Preserve.

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. - 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
