Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable disease, and have appropriate vaccinations.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

Tracking Test is for dogs not less than six months old. With the entry form for the TD Test of a dog which has not passed a "Tracking Test" there must be filed a written statement by a person who is accredited by the AKC to judge a "Tracking Test" that the dog is considered by the judge to be ready for such a test. An exhibitor may enter more than one dog. Entries without a Tracking Dog (TD) title.

The Tracking Dog Test will be limited to 6 Weimaraners. If the limit is not reached in Weimaraners, other breeds may enter using the following procedure: Draw (1) Weimaraners without a TD title, Draw (2) Weimaraners with a TD title, Draw (3) Other breeds without a TD title, Draw (4) Other breeds with a TD title. Bitches in season may participate (refer to AKC Tracking Regulations, Chapter 2, Section 8, and notify Test Secretary prior to the drawing for track order on the day of the test).

THERE will be no actual scores for the TD Test, but dogs will be rated "Passed" or "Failed" and TD certificate will be issued by the AKC confirming all dogs rated "Passed".

Telephone, facsimile, e-mail, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries sent by overnight delivery service MUST include signature release.

ENTRY FEE is \$60.00 for the TD Test (includes 50 cents AKC Recording Fee & \$3.00 event fee) made payable to the Weimaraner Club of Northern Illinois in U. S. Funds.

IN ACCORDANCE with the AKC Obedience Regulations (Chapter 1,) ENTRIES in this TD test will be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. A drawing will be held at Starbuck's, 1001 Armitage Ave., Chicago, IL, on Thursday, April 21, 2016 at 7:00 P.M. to determine which entries will participate in the test. The draw is open to the public. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth above, will be similarly drawn and assigned a position on an alternate list. The Test Secretary will then notify all entries of the results of the draw. Entries will be acknowledged with a draw number and map and directions to the test site. There will be no drawing if the advertised limit is not reached.

IN THE EVENT that an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it will be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternates are present, and to determine, by their position on the Alternate List, which alternates shall participate.

NO entry fee will be refunded except that of an alternate who does not participate in the test. Exception: In the event that an accepted entry withdraws from the test and an alternate replaces that entry, refund will be made to the withdrawn entry.

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
